


Movement & the School

This school was established in the year 1984 in collaboration with Coal India Limited in order to provide quality education to the children of the BCCL employees and the people of the locality as well. The school got affiliated to CBSE upto STD X in the year 1987 and upto STD XII (Arts, Science and Commerce) in the year 1992. The present strength of the school is nearly 2700 from LKG to STD XII with four and five sections in almost all the classes. The school is scaling new heights every year in scholastic and non scholastic areas & trying to come up with expectations of students and parents.



Our Visionary Figure



Admission

Generally the admission is taken in LKG and UKG and few admissions in STD-I

Age Limit:

LKG: 3 years 6 months
UKG: 4 years 6 months

STD-I: 5 years to 5 years 6 months

Documents Required:

Birth Certificate (Issued by Municipality/Block Authority)

Admission in Classes II to VIII are taken only against the vacant seats/T.C.

For Classes IX & X admission strictly on transfer basis from affiliated schools only.

Admission in Class XI through screening test and on merit basis.

Documents Required:

Transfer Certificate, Character Certificate, Duly attested copy of marksheet and Migration certificate. Health card and current pay slip (for BCCL ward)
