Attendance & Withdrawals

Parents must ensure the regular attendance of their ward.

75% attendance is must for every student. Incase, one does not meet the minimum required attendance, he/she shall be debarred from appearing the exam.

One can withdraw his/her child by serving one month's notice or one month's fee in lieu of.

One can withdraw his/her child if he/she fails to show satisfactory progress in any class for two consecutive years.

The school has right to expel the child if his/her behavior in the opinion of the head of the institution and disciplinary committee is harmful in the interest of academic atmosphere of the school.

Guidelines for Parents & Students

- Application for leave must be submitted a day in advance. It should be counter signed by the Parents/Guardian.
- Students must come in time in proper school uniform. If anyone is late or dress defaulter, he/she shall not be allowed to enter the campus.
- Students must obey House Captain and other Port Folio on duty.
- Students are not allowed to leave the school during working hours unless the Parents / Guardians request personally.
- School identity card must be with the students on all working days.
- Any damage to the school property by the student will have to be borne by the student's Parents/Guardians.
- The school reserves the right to take stern action to struck-off the name of the students from the school register if anyone is found guilty in any case or remain absent for two months regularly.
